We are a Catholic, college-preparatory school that embraces each student's unique God-given gifts and educates each student as a whole person: shaping leaders in mind, body, and spirit.




LETTER OF INTRODUCTION

■ FACILITIES GOAL

OBJECTIVES

- ✓ Evaluate and replace the existing five-year facilities plan with a comprehensive campus master plan to be communicated to all stakeholders
- ✓ Review current safety plans and procedures, and modify them to meet best practices



■ FINANCE GOAL

Duchesne will be a self-sufficient, high-performing, premier Catholic high school of choice.

OBJECTIVES

- ✓ Research the ability to raise funds, including an annual fundraising plan and capital campaign feasibility study
- ✓ Create and execute a communication plan, including results, to the Duchesne community for the school's financial status, needs, and future plans
- ✓ Create a five-year plan that allows the school to be self-sufficient



■ GOVERNANCE GOAL

Duchesne will implement a transparent governance model that is aligned with our values, mission, and vision; ensures our long-term success; and is representative of all of our stakeholders.

OBJECTIVES

- ✓ Communicate the roles and responsibilities of the archdiocese, school administration, and school board to ensure they are clearly understood by the broader school community
- ✓ Provide consistent, timely, and open communication about operations, plans, and decisions from the archdiocese, school administration, and school board leveraging a wide range of methods and feedback mechanisms
- ✓ Implement a formalized evaluation process to ensure all school faculty, staff, and leadership have regular performance reviews
- ✓ Formalize plans for identifying, recruiting, and replacing administration, board, and non-board committee members



■ STUDENT LIFE GOAL

Duchesne will foster a culture in which learners develop meaningful connections, embrace open-mindedness, advocate for themselves, and prepare to successfully navigate school and life with confidence and resilience.

OBJECTIVES

- ✓ Establish a four-year plan to meet the academic and college counseling needs of each student in partnership with their families
- ✓ Create a data-gathering mechanism that will routinely gather, analyze, and disseminate student-life data to our stakeholders in order to make better decisions
- ✓ Research schedule options to modify the current schedule to best accommodate students' needs and interests
- ✓ Research student needs and implement a Wellness Program to support students' mental health, wellness, and life balance
