Hello all,

The focus of this week's letter will be on our seniors. This week marks the start of our fourth quarter and their last quarter as Duchesne students. If

thoughts haven't already turned to graduation and life as Duchesne alumni, they will certainly move in that direction now that we have reached spring break.

Last spring the administration and advancement staff started planning for our 100 year anniversary. As part of our anniversary festivities, we decided to celebrate graduation at St. Peter Church, the place where our school started 100 years ago. We were moving forward with that plan, and I had hoped to use this letter to outline how graduation would look this year. This week, however, we encountered an obstacle.

Unfortunately there was a miscommunication between Duchesne and St. Peter. We will not be using St. Peter for graduation, and consequently, we will fall back to the way we have conducted the graduation ceremonies for the last several years. A baccalaureate mass and senior awards ceremony will likely be held on Tuesday, May 14th. The graduation ceremony will be held at Duchesne in the Ted Yeater Athletic Center on Thursday, May 16.

DHS cheer program under new leadership

Severs attended Missouri Baptist University, earning a degree in education. Growing up, she danced at Gou-Jon Academy of Dance for 16 years, danced as a pommer in high school, and has since coached young athletes in tumbling, stunts, and skills.



FROM THE SPORTS DESK

A new helmet with a retro look

Duchesne's football players will hit the field this fall sporting some impressive new gear with a throw-back design.

The helmets for the 2024 football season feature a retro look in honor of Duchesne's 100th year — blue decals outlined in red trim — as well as other unique design elements.

"We are the only school in the world that has the matte white finish with blue metal flake," said Duchesne Head Football Coach Vince Morris.

The helmets were manufactured by Riddell, who created the new technologically advanced helmets the Pioneers wore last season.

The specialty helmets are made from a 3D model of the wearer, resulting in a fit that is more efficient at protecting from injury. Morris explained that although this year's look is updated, the technology is the same.

Duchesne alumni will probably recognize the design.

"With Duchesne celebrating the 100th anniversary of the school, Vince thought it would be a great tribute to the early years of Pioneer football to implement the traditional white helmet with blue decals and red trim," said Duchesne Athletic Director Paul Boschert '77. "When I attended Duchesne in the



mid-70s, our football helmets were white with blue decals but a little red trim. Our basketball and baseball uniforms were predominantly blue and white, but

some lettering was outlined in red."

Morris developed the final design with the assistance of Missouri Helmet Project.

SPRING SPORTS PAPERWORK
